



Navigation Guidelines for Sixth Grade

RESPECT YOURSELF:

- Students will raise their hand to address the class or teacher.
- Upon entering the classroom, students will sit in their assigned seat and prepare for class.
- Pencils should be sharpened before class begins.
- Students will bring all needed supplies to class. You will not be allowed to return to your locker to get supplies without being penalized.

RESPECT OTHERS:

- Insubordination will not be tolerated. If your name is mentioned in a note from a substitute teacher, a detention will be assigned.
- Students will demonstrate respect for others and their property.
- Students will be dismissed from class by their teacher, not the bell.
- Horseplay or running is not permitted.
- Students will not be excused from class to use the restroom unless it is an emergency, otherwise the restroom should be used between classes.

RESPECT PROPERTY:

- Students will sit on chairs, not tables.
- No food, candy, or drink may be consumed in the classroom without the teacher's approval.
- Chromebooks should be carried in the school provided case only and should NEVER be removed from the case or placed in a backpack.

Work Habits Grade:

- Each student will receive a work habits grade on their report card each nine weeks. This grade will be based on the behavior and work ethic exhibited in the 4 core subjects.

Penmanship

- If we cannot read your writing, you will be asked to redo the work.

Assignment books

- All assignments should be written down daily in the agenda book provided by the school.
- All core subject assignments are posted in each classroom and on Moodle

Absence

- You are responsible for getting make up work completed and turned in to the teacher.
See teacher before school or during homebase. (See the handbook for specifics)

Papers

- Keep all papers in your Math notebook/folder, Social Studies folder, Language Arts folder or Science binder.

INABILITY TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES, AS STATED ABOVE, WILL RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. Verbal Warning
2. Written Warning (student's name on board for 5 days), possible parent contact.
 - Name could be written on the board for the following:
 - Missing supplies
 - Inappropriate behavior
 - Missing assignments (No verbal warning will be given)
 - Assignments need to be turned in promptly in order to avoid additional check marks
3. For each subsequent infraction within those 5 days a checkmark will be given.
4. Receiving 2 checkmarks anytime during those 5 days will result in a teacher-assigned detention. A detention form will be sent home with one or more days' notice. Student will be held for one-half hour after school on the designated date noted on the form. This form needs to be signed by a parent and returned the next school day.
5. Principal Referral - Principal referral could result in
 - An administrative detention
 - Saturday School
 - In-School Suspension
 - Out-of-School Suspension
 - Recommendation for Expulsion

*Any severe behavior may be immediately escalated to a principal referral
