A coordinate plane is formed by two number lines that intersect at right angles. The point of intersection is 0 on each number line.

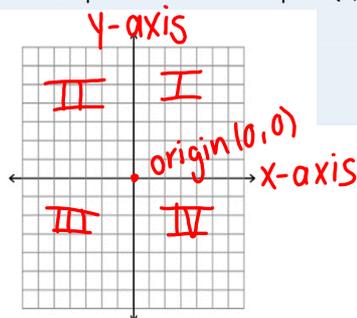
The horizontal axis is called the x-axis.

The vertical axis is called the y-axis.

The point where the axes intersect is called the origin this is at the ordered pair (0,0).

The coordinate plane is divided into four quadrants.

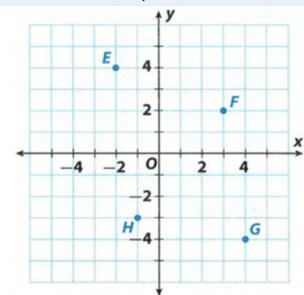
An ordered pair is a pair of numbers that gives the location of a point on a coordinate plane (x, y)

**25 mi W and 15 mi N**

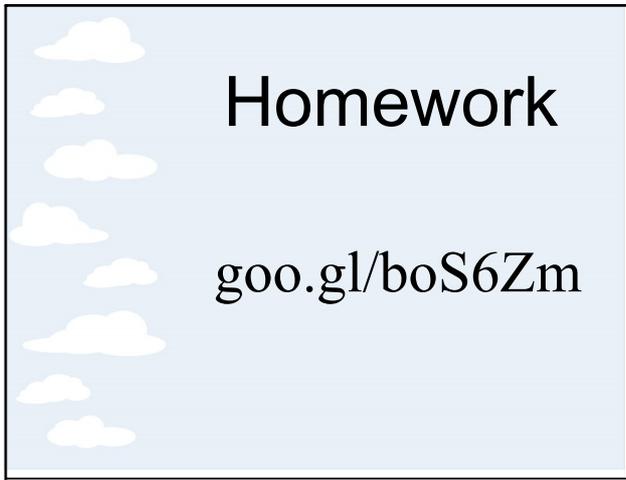
b.) Describe the location of Jen's house relative to Gary's house.
